

Packing Checklist for Boarding

- **Food**

We prefer meals portioned in baggies to ensure proper measurements – Airtight storage is required to maintain freshness! *Please do not bring dog food bags that are not sealable.*

- **Medication**

Daily meds, “just in case” meds, and or anxiety meds that your pup may need during their stay. We offer smokey flavor pill pockets (Greenies brand), but if your pup has a special treat to hide their medication in, bring that too!

- **Snacks and Treats**

We do not offer treats that are not brought from home (unless approved prior) because so many friends have allergies! Please keep in mind that all snacks and treats must be safe for them to consume even if unsupervised.

- **Bedding**

We cannot provide bedding, but you can bring anything from home that would make your pup comfortable for their stay. For more anxious pups, we suggest bringing at least one item that smells like home! Belongings must be machine washable and labeled just in case!

- **Collar/Harness and Leash**

All pups must enter the building on leash. Although we do not typically use these items during their stay, it’s best to have it with the pup to make pick-up easier!

- **Vaccinations**

Double check that your pup is up-to-date on Bordetella, Rabies, and Distemper vaccines prior to drop off! You’re welcome to call us to make sure we have the most current records on file.

- **Accessories and Toys**

Leave your pup’s bowls at home unless they need a specific type. (Aka slow feeders or raised bowls). We have plenty of metal bowls for everyone to use!

*Toys must be safe for your pup to play with while in their rooms overnight. We advise against plush toys if your pup is known to be destructive!

What NOT to bring:

*Rope toys

*Prized possessions (ex: your fave shirt, their first blankie, etc.)

*New treats or food

*Comforters and large quilts

*Beds without removeable covers for easy washing
